### GENERAL INFORMATION

All team sports are divided into the following divisions for both men and women: 50+; 55+; 60+; 65+, 70+, and 75+. In addition, 3-on-3 basketball shall have an 80+ age division. Age divisions for competition will be determined by the age of the athlete as of December 31, 2016. For the team, the age division will be determined by the age of the youngest participant on their team as of December 31, 2018. No onsite registration is allowed. Cannot guarantee team placement if requested. All athletes must register separately and pay the registration fee. Team captain is responsible for registering the team.

### PACKET PICKUP

Packet can be picked up at location site.

### ENTRY REGULATIONS

1. Teams must be of one gender.
2. Team roster shall be limited to 15 persons, including non-playing coaches, non-playing captains and non-playing bench personnel. Roster changes shall be allowed only as permitted under Rule F.
3. Teams are no longer limited to the number of out-of-state players on their rosters; however roster changes shall be allowed only as permitted under Rule F. It is the captain's responsibility to declare team residency subject to NSGA approval, at the time of registration.
4. All registration and team rules apply to non-playing coaches, non-playing captains and non-playing bench personnel.
5. At the National Senior Games athletes may compete on up to two teams per sport providing that the teams are in different age divisions that are scheduled to play in completely separate sessions.
6. Age divisions for all team competition will be determined by the age of the youngest team member as of December 31, 2019.

### QUALIFYING RULES

1. All first-, second- and third-place winners at a 2018 NSGA qualifying games will qualify for the 2019 National Senior Games.

## **MEDALS**

Medals are given to 1<sup>st</sup> (Gold), 2<sup>nd</sup> (Silver), 3<sup>rd</sup> (Bronze) in each age group. The Indiana State Games allows and encourages athletes from out of state to participate. The definition of an athlete's state of residence is that state in which the person resides for at least six months out of the year.

## **EQUIPMENT**

Official game volleyballs will be provided. All other volleyballs are property of USI. Time clock, and scoreboard will be provided by ISG. Official Paid Referees for all Volleyball games.
